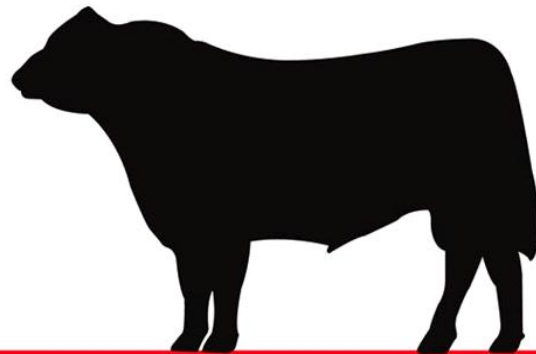

Conditions of Entry

1. Open to all contestants between the age of 0 and 25 years.
2. Open to heifers under 21 months of age as at 1st April, 2009. Futurity class open to all heifers that competed in the 2008 Qld Angus Heifer Show. Open to bulls under 18 months of age as at 1st April, 2009. Open to led steers showing which must have at least one Angus parent.
3. Open to heifers and bulls registered as either HBR, APR or ACR with Angus Australia and the Red Angus Society and purebred unregistered Angus and Red Angus heifers.
4. Cattle may be on the grounds from than 4pm Friday 24th April. Yard area is available for the weekend as well as tie-up stalls.
5. Closing Date for entries is 17st April 2009.
6. Competitors must be a current Junior or Full member of Angus Australia or either a full time student of a School, College or Institute.
7. Heifers, bulls & steers will be available for loan for competitors who require them from a range of Queensland studs who are supporting this competition. If they are required then this ***must be requested*** on the enclosed form stating the classes they are required for and locality preferred. Please either mail the form to the address provided ASAP or fax by March 27 to secure animals. Competitors will be given studs to contact to organize cattle.
8. Insurance and Public Liability is the responsibility of the competitor with all competitors entering at their own risk. Both the contestants and the owners of the animals will sign an indemnity form releasing to the full extent permitted by Law, Angus Australia Limited, the Queensland Angus Committee and its members, and the Bell Show Society and its servants, agents and contractors and employees from any claims and demands, damages, costs and expenses of every kind resulting from any accident, damage, loss or injury howsoever caused. Failure to sign the indemnity will result in entries being rejected.
9. All cattle to have NLIS device and the NLIS number on the device is to be provided on the entry form along with the PIC which the animal is to be transferred from. All cattle will be transferred back onto this PIC upon leaving the grounds. There will not be any scanning of devices as this will be performed by faxed notification to the NLIS database.

10. Nose grips or nose rings are compulsory. All bulls are to have nose-rings. There will be no exceptions to this rule so please ensure that cattle are broken in using one.
11. Cattle are to be attended to by the *competitor only* whilst on show grounds. Sub juniors and juniors can be assisted however competitors over 12 years of age are not permitted to be assisted on judging day.
12. Final classes for both cattle and competitors will be determined after the close of entries at Queensland Junior Angus Committee's discretion.
13. Appropriate clothing and footwear is to be worn by competitors at all times – no thongs, or open footwear are permitted whilst working with cattle.
14. Exhibitors must supply their own feed and equipment.
15. The health status of cattle must conform to the district's veterinary officer's requirements and documentation verifying such must be available if required.
16. All exhibits are to be docile and broken in to lead. Inspections will be carried out with competitors needing to show they are capable of controlling their heifers. Juniors under 12 years of age may be assisted by an adult/parent in the show ring in the role of a co-leader during judging of classes.
17. No dogs are allowed to be on the grounds.
18. The Qld Junior Angus Committee reserve the right to refuse entry of cattle should they not be of an acceptable level of quality and docility.
19. Competitors and their cattle are to have departed the show grounds by 4pm on Sunday afternoon.
20. Full catering at reasonable rates will be supplied on site at the show grounds for all meals for the weekend and it would be greatly appreciated if this could be supported. Menus and prices are available should you require one. Please indicate on entry form the number of persons in total who will be attending the weekend to give an indication for catering purposes. Camping is permitted on the grounds and there are shower facilities available. All demonstrations and instruction sessions will be held on Saturday and judging of heifers and paraders will be on Sunday. Non participants are most welcome to attend on both days.
